

The IUCN Red list Workshop

From 20 to 24 May the IUCN organised a workshop training on the Red list. The main trainer was Prof. Philippe A. LALEYE from the University of Abomey-Calavi, Republic of Benin (<http://www.lha-uac.net>). He was assisted by Dr Delphine ADANDEDJAN (a female scientist) of the same university. The goal was to train scientists of Burkina Faso in the IUCN Red list. There were about 15 attendees from the IUCN, the Laboratory of Animal Biology and Ecology of the University of Ouagadougou, the Fisheries Department of the Ministry of Animal and Fish Resources, the Wildlife Department of the Ministry of Environment and Sustainable Development and the Department of Forest Production of the Institute for Environment and Agriculture Research, Ministry of Research and Innovation. A road map was developed at the end of the workshop.
