1.Global objective



 Favor the participation of the stakeholders particularly vulnerable groups in the process of research to guarantee an appropriation and a valuation of the results

2.Gender issue and fisheries management



- Disparities of access to the resources;
- Low power of control and decision over in the use of water and halieutics by vulnerable groups and particularly women;
- Continuous and irreversible increase in food needs / in water;
- Increasing imbalance in well-being between men and women, the rich and the poor etc. Potential sources of conflict which can also lead the humanity in large-scale social crises.
- Scientific research generally directed to the production performed mainly by men

- Promotion of gender, a principle of the Accelerated Growth strategy and Sustainable development of Burkina Faso (Stratégie de Croissance Accélérée et de Développement Durable)
